



BOARD OPERATOR

Working under the authority of the Technical Director, the board operator ensures proper and safe set-up or strike of all lighting elements of the show. The person must be available to work on a variable schedule.

RESPONSABILITIES:

- Supervise Lighting Department operations;
- Troubleshoot lighting equipment for performances, artist and horses training, and maintenance;
- Back up console operators and programmers, as well as other lighting department show positions;
- Preserve the ongoing, long-term integrity of lighting during performances and rehearsals in keeping with the original intent of the Lighting Designer;
- Inspect and maintain lighting equipment and systems; update maintenance and inspection records as directed;
- Develop maintenance systems and procedures specific to the production design;
- Work with the technical team to develop and maintain a safe working environment by leading the lighting team in adhering to all established safety policies and procedures;
- Maintain a flexible schedule for work calls, special events, rehearsal/training, maintenance and evening show performances;

SKILLS / EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

- 5 years experience in a equivalent job
- Training and technical knowledge of lighting console operation systems ;
- Experience as a lighting operator and programmer for a touring production involving live performers and animals;
- Experience with repairs and troubleshooting, and the use of digital test equipment to perform such repairs;
- Experience in rigging and maintenance of lighting equipment in a big top structure on a custom-designed grid;
- Experience with mobile structures and loading requirements for lighting equipment transportation.
- Bilingual (English and French languages)
- Available to work full time on tour and authorized to work in Canada and USA.
