



COSTUMES ASSISTANT

DESCRIPTION:

Under the supervision of the artistic operations director, the costumes assistant is in charge of all the adjustments and maintenance of the costumes as well as the storage and transportation of all the costumes, accessories and make up between cities. The person must be available to work on a variable schedule.

RESPONSABILITIES

- Assist the head of wardrobe in supervising operations of the wardrobe department and coordinate activities in the absence of the Head of department;
- Run cue tracks to position and maintain costumes and related accessories as used during the performances, artists and horses rehearsals, and maintenance.
- Assist the artists with dressing and quick changes;
- Participate in cue track rotation ;
- Assisting the Head of Wardrobe with maintaining the long-term integrity of the costumes, shoes, hats and accessories, equestrian gear during performances and rehearsal;
- Maintain a safe working environment adhering to all established safety policies and procedures;
- Be on call for special events, during rehearsals and training, as wells as for maintenance and evening show performances;
- Perform any other tasks necessary to ensure operations run smoothly

SKILLS / EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

- Thoroughly trained, and extensive technical knowledge with costume repair, shoe repair, equestrian gear on large-scale productions;
- Extensive experience as the assistant to a professional costume dresser for large scale productions involving artists and animals;
- Experience with mobile structures and thorough knowledge of the loading requirements for the transportation of all costumes, accessories and equestrian gears;
- Bilingual (English and French).
